- Times:** A typical tour which includes both the Lighthouse and Keeper's Dwelling will take about 40 minutes. Please allow more time for larger groups.
- Lighthouse:** Visitors are welcome to climb to the top of the lighthouse to see the Fresnel lens and the vistas. There is a height requirement of 42 inches to climb to the top. The lighthouse has 28 steps and a 8-rung ladder to the top. The ladder ascends through a trap door into the lantern room. *Children who are frightened should not be made to climb to the top.* The granite steps of the lighthouse can be slippery from moisture. Visitors should ascend slowly and use the handrails at all times. Flip-flops are not appropriate footwear to climb the lighthouse.
- Keeper's House:** The Keeper's Dwelling is across the street from the Lighthouse. The building has been restored to its 1884 appearance. Interpretive displays and exhibits are available for visitors. Informational signs around the property are another source of information for visitors.
- Gift Shop:** The Gift Shop can be available with prior notice.
- Restrooms:** We do not have restroom facilities. There are public restrooms a short distance away at Tydings Park.
- Picnic Facilities:** Picnic tables are available at Tydings Park.
- Donations:** Although we do not charge admission fees, a \$1.00 a person donation is suggested, and would be appreciated.
- Weather:** The Lighthouse is closed during rain and stormy conditions, although the Keepers Dwelling is always available. Please consider a rain date if seeing the Lighthouse is important to your group.
